- Full motorbike rental for the duration of the tour. (Suzuki V-Strom 650 or BMW 650 GS with top-box, both bikes are best suited to the roads and traffic conditions of Turkey and highly recommended by Turkey Moto Adventures, limited number of bigger bikes (BMW R1200GS, Honda Varadero 1000 or Suzuki V-Strom 1000) can be arranged at an extra cost depending on the availability.
- Boutique Hotel accommodation throughout the tour.
- Twin-share basis; (single room supplement, additional Aus\$500.00) ¹
- All meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner), including coffee or tea
- Experienced guide, local agent and qualified mechanics.
- Minibus support vehicle and driver, for luggage, transport and assistance.
- Spare parts, tools, medicines and first aid equipment
- All fuel costs, maintenance, third party and comprehensive insurance for the bikes
- Airport transfers

Price

The tour price, excluding airfares is Aus\$7,500.00. Riders must have a valid and unrestricted rider's licence. Pillions are welcome. Price for pillion is Aus\$6,000.00. Please note that our prices are subject to exchange rates and we reserve the right to alter any pricing, pursuant to Clause 7 of our Terms and Conditions herewith, up to the date of final payment.

Deposit and Full Payment

Deposit is Aus\$1,000.00 per person to secure booking and full payment is required 45 days prior to departure.

- Expenses of a personal nature such as postage, laundry, souvenirs or alcoholic drinks.

¹ Accommodation is provided on a twin-share basis and if you're on your own we'll do our best to match you in with an acceptable roommate. But if you're the last person to book, there's obviously a 50-50 chance you'll have to take a room on your own and therefore be liable for the single room supplement. So the moral of the story is, book early or bring your own roommate with you.

² Please note that a motorcycle touring overseas must be considered one of life's more adventurous pursuits and we highly recommend travel insurance.



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ITINERARY FOR “WESTERN TURKEY” TOUR

Day 1 - Istanbul

Arrive into Istanbul Ataturk Airport early in the morning. You will be greeted by a representative of Turkey Moto Adventures and taken to Celal Sultan Hotel for overnight accommodation. On the first day we'll visit museums, mosques and the grand bazaar. The city's smells, sounds and vibrant atmosphere will awaken your senses for the enjoyable trip ahead!

Day 2 & 3 - Gallipoli

Check in at Aqua Hotel in Gallipoli. We will spend two days exploring the battlefields, tunnels and trenches of Anzac Cove and Shrapnel Valley, monuments such as Lone Pine (Australian Cemetery), Chunuk Bair (Kiwi Cemetery), and the excellent Anzac Museum!

Day 4 – Cunda Island

Check in at Cunda Hotel. We indulge ourselves in the calm seas and excellent seafood in Cunda which is a small island in the north-western Aegean Sea off the coast of Ayvalik. Explore the Aegean style of living at its best!

Day 5 - Foca

Arrive in Foca and check in to Focantique Butik Otel for one night. Foca is named after the Mediterranean Monk Seals; it is an unspoilt eden-like fishermen town with its historical ambiance and natural beauties. The road heading into Foca will take your breath away as well as the local ambiance!

Day 6 & 7 - Kusadasi

Check into Pine Bay Marine Hotel. Kusadasi is a popular resort town for all the cruise ships stopping here on the Aegean island-hop circuit. We visit the ruins of Efes, (or Ephesus), the grandest and best preserved classical city on the Mediterranean. Also the House of the Virgin Mary is on the list for the second day!

Day 8 & 9 – Bodrum

Check into El Vino Hotel. Bodrum is a unique and diverse town in that it offers resort style holidays, excellent shopping, dining and a great nightlife but at the same time fervently maintaining its cultural and historical heritage. Day or night Bodrum has it all!

Day 10 & 11 – Pamukkale

Check into Hierapolis Hotel. Pamukkale is located 20 kilometres from the town of Denizli in the Aegean region of Turkey. Pamukkale is one of the most interesting places in the world, justly famous not only for the entrancing beauty of its unique geological formations but also for its historical remain as well as the thermal waters (hydro carbonate, sulphur, calcium, carbon dioxide and iron) that are suitable for drinking and bathing. It is believed that drinking and bathing in these waters helps heart and circulatory complaints as well as digestive, gall bladder, rheumatic and kidney diseases.

Day 12 – Kutahya

Check into Gural Harlek Thermal Resort. Kutahya is a small province in the midst of hill country in Turkey, clustering about the walls of an impressive hilltop fortress. It is the hometown of the world famous Yagcibedir Carpets, and Kutahya tiles which you can see everywhere in the country. The tiles and the porcelain are especially famous for their cobalt blue on a milky white background.

Day 13 – Iznik

Check into Camlik Hotel. Iznik is remarkable for the monuments belonging to the Roman, Byzantine and Ottoman Age. Most of the historical buildings are well preserved. Thus the region looks like an open-air museum. That's why Iznik is proclaimed as an historical urban place to be protected.

Day 14 – Istanbul

Check into Celal Sultan Hotel. We explore Istanbul a bit more, with a ferry cruise up the Bosphorus followed by perhaps a shopping expedition to the Grand Bazaar for those mandatory last-minute souvenirs and T-shirts for the family back home. Then we'll gather for a final farewell dinner in a local restaurant.

Day 15 – Istanbul

A representative from the Turkey Moto Adventures will drive you to Ataturk Airport for your flight back home.

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TERMS & CONDITIONS

You must carefully read and agree to the following Terms and Conditions, which form part of the contract you enter into by joining one of our adventure holidays.

1. A duly completed Booking Form, together with the prerequisite initial payment, shall be sent to our office to confirm your place.
2. The full balance is due and payable 45 days prior to departure. Your booking may be considered cancelled if the full balance is not received at this office by that time.
3. Should you have to cancel your trip we must receive notice in writing, either by mail or email. If this is received more than 45 days prior to departure, 50% of your payment will be refunded, or up to 100% at our discretion. If received with less than 45 days notice, any refund will be solely at our discretion.
4. You are responsible for ensuring that you are fit and healthy enough to participate in this trip. We reserve the right to insist on a medical certificate from your doctor stating that you are in a suitable condition. We recommend anyone joining this trip to take regular exercise for a period of time before departure. If you suffer from heart, chest, muscular or respiratory disorders, severe asthma or high blood pressure, we strongly advise against joining this trip.
5. Should the number of participants booked on any trip not meet the minimum requirement for us to operate that trip, we reserve the right to cancel the trip. Your payment will be refunded in full if we are unable to transfer you to another trip to your satisfaction.
6. It may become necessary, due to weather, local conditions, politics or various other reasons, to make changes to trip itineraries. Such changes will always be eventually at the sole discretion of the Tour Leader and no refund will be considered in the event of such changes.
7. The trip costs published within this itinerary are accurate at the time of delivery and we make all endeavours to maintain these costs. However some time this is beyond our control and we reserve the right to amend our prices up to the date of departure in the event of significant exchange rate fluctuation, increased fuel costs, taxes, insurance policies or increases in the costs charged by ground operators.
8. We take no responsibility for any flight delays or schedule changes at any stage throughout the trip. In the event of any such changes no refund will be considered.
9. This Booking Form and Contract is not issued on behalf of any airline or carrier and does not constitute any commitment on their behalf in the course of this trip.
10. The trip cost does not include personal travel or medical insurance. We insist that you take out a personal travel insurance policy and may request proof of same. It is your responsibility to ensure suitable insurance cover is taken out prior to commencement of the trip.
11. The trip pricing does not include any passport or visa charges, any excess baggage charges, or incidental daily expenditure of a personal nature whilst on the trip.
12. The motorcycle we provide you with will be comprehensively insured, but you will be liable for the first US\$1,500.00 worth of any damage to the motorcycle deemed by Turkey Moto Adventures to have been your responsibility.

14. The Trade Practises Act 1974 Act imply into contracts for supply of goods and services certain non-excludable conditions and warranties. Except to the extent as provided by these Acts, you waive any and all claims you may have against, now and in the future, and release from all liability and agree not to sue, Turkey Moto Adventures and its officers, employees, guides, agents and representatives (collectively, 'Staff') for any personal injury, death, property damage, loss or inconvenience sustained by you as a result of joining this trip, due to any cause whatsoever including but without any limitation, perceived negligence on the part of Turkey Moto Adventures or its Staff.
15. In consideration of your Booking Form and deposit being accepted, you agree to this release of claims, waiver of liability and assumption of risk (collectively, "this Agreement").
16. You acknowledge that this adventure trip, in addition to the usual dangers and risks inherent in travel, has certain additional dangers and risks introduced by the nature of the trip. You accept all these inherent risks of the trip and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting from your decision to participate.
17. You agree that should you suffer any serious injury or illness, Turkey Moto Adventures can arrange, at any cost to be borne by you, urgent medical treatment and emergency evacuation procedures as deemed essential to your safety.
18. In entering into this Agreement, you are not relying upon any oral or visual representation or statements by Turkey Moto Adventures or its Staff or any other inducement or coercion to participate in this trip. You go only of your own volition and free will.
19. You confirm that you are over 18 years of age and that you have read, understood and accepted all these Terms and Conditions of contract prior to signing this Agreement and agree that this Agreement shall be binding upon your heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and successors.
20. You agree that this Agreement shall be governed in all respects in accordance with the Laws of the Australian State of Western Australia.
